Commencement Regalia (Cap and Gown)

Commencement regalia are a requirement for all degree candidates to participate in the Convocation and Commencement Ceremony.

- Bible Certificate graduates will not need to purchase regalia.
- Associate-level graduates will wear blue robes and red tassels.
- Bachelor's-level graduates will wear black robes and gold tassels.
- For those graduates who have earned academic honors, CBS will purchase and supply honor cords for associate-level graduates and honor medals for bachelor's-level graduates. Honor awards will be presented at the graduation dinner.

Dress Attire (Attire to be worn under regalia)

Business/church attire; see below.

Attire to be worn under regalia and for participating award candidates is as follows:

- Male: White dress shirt, modest tie, dark slacks and/or suit jacket, dark socks/shoes.
- Female: Modest dark dress or dark slacks and nice modest shirt and dark dress shoes (heels or flats are fine).

Diplomas and Awards

Candidates will receive a diploma cover at the time of the Commencement Ceremony.

The official CBS diploma for graduates will be mailed to the address on file with CBS 6 to 8 weeks after commencement or 6 to 8 weeks after the conferral date.
